Meeting Date: October 26, 2024.

MEETINGS SUMMARY: District 16 currently has twenty-one active meetings: nine meetings are virtual; three meetings are hybrid, and nine meetings are face-to-face.

Peninsula District continues to meet in a hybrid format, every other month, for two hours (9:30-11:30am). The last meeting was held September 14, 2024, at Yorkminster Presbyterian Church. Eighteen members attended.

We have one remaining District meeting planned this year. It is scheduled for November 9, 2024.

Today a New Frontier AFG hosted an Anniversary Speaker luncheon on May 23, 2024. Approximately 50 members enjoyed food and fellowship at a well-organized speaker luncheon.

A father/daughter duo were featured speakers at the Peninsula District picnic on June 22, 2024. Approximately 50 members gathered next to the lake at Newport News Park for an afternoon of fellowship and fun.
